## A Letter from Long-time AFAC Volunteer Don Hartline

Dear Friends of AFAC,

At a time when a troubled economy has left the country's charities stretching shrinking resources to meet rising demand, the unwavering supporters of the Arlington Food Assistance Center (AFAC) are on the verge of cementing a lasting legacy of this community's longstanding commitment to feed our struggling neighbors.

While Arlington has sustained the lowest unemployment in the state, its high cost of living leaves the most vulnerable citizens facing hard choices, which makes AFAC's mission more critical than ever. Each day, AFAC staff and volunteers witness bleak realities in serving many families who never imagined they would seek the help of a food pantry. AFAC distributes food to 1,200 families each week. Of those assisted, 40% are children.

Affirming its pledge to Arlingtonians in need, the AFAC Board approved purchase of its current facility on South Nelson Street to stake claim as a permanent partner in the county's social service system. What may have seemed impossible to some in 2007 is now deemed fortuitous as the Permanent Home Campaign enters its home stretch. Less than four years of work, dedication and dreaming has raised \$735,000 of the \$1 million needed to retire the mortgage and secure its future in a location known to and convenient for its clients.

This is your opportunity to secure a good seat at the finish line for what will become a singular testament to the generosity of our community. At a juncture where our

neighbors' growing needs have reached a critical state, it requires little imagination to envision the greater impact our efforts can have once we can devote all of our resources to AFAC's core purpose—providing the most nutritious and fresh food we can to Arlington families.

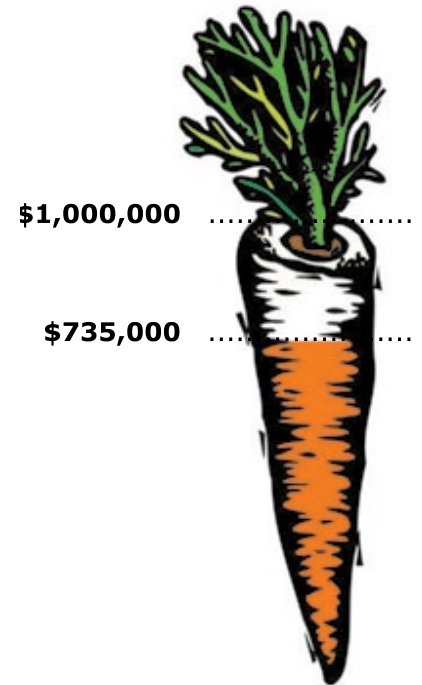
